



REENTRY & COMMUNITY TRANSITION (REACT) PROGRAM

HOW IT WORKS

NeighborWorks Alaska works closely with the AKDOC, and other community stakeholders from the Anchorage Reentry Coalition, to coordinate **pre-&post prison release access to services for medium-to high-risk reentrants that are determined by a current LSIR Assessment.**

This is a **short-term service over a nine-month period** that begins, in the AKDOC facility, three months prior to release and continues for approximately six months after release.

Participants in this program will work closely with our ReEntry Support Specialist to identify barriers and needs to maintain stability after release. **NeighborWorks Alaska connects individuals with employment, housing, medical, behavioral health, substance use treatments, and/or other supportive services** to assist individuals to become self-sufficient before exiting our REACT Program.

HOW TO QUALIFY

- Release Date within the next 90 days; no more than 6 months past release date.
- Spent at least 30 days incarcerated.
- Felon with at least moderate level LSI-R score, sex offense or misdemeanor with high LSI-R score.
- Releasing into Anchorage Area.
- Willing to reside in sober transitional housing, find employment or reconnect with social security benefits, while participating in the REACT program with NeighborWorks Alaska.
